Parisian singer, *Carolyn Saint-Pé* and her quartet *The Sparrows of Paris* transport you in time and space to Paris of yesteryear with a repertoire of vintage french chansons and the authentic jazz-musette of the 1930s and 40s.

### The repertoire

Composed of accordion, clarinet, guitar and double bass, *The Sparrows of Paris* bring you the chansons of the beginning of the twentieth century (Edith Piaf, Fréhel, Mistinguett, Arletty etc) and the authentic jazz-musette of the 1930s and 40s. *The Sparrows of Paris* continue the tradition of the bals musette, the popular social dances of the 1920s to 1940s with dances such as javas, tangos and foxtrots. With their first album, *The Sparrows of Paris* added a couple of new javas written in a similar retro style.

The Sparrows of Paris' first album is called JAVAS and contains some of the most loved example of this dance music of the beginning of the twentieth century such as La java de Cézigue and J'suis mordue originally sung by a young Edith Piaf, La java bleue and La der des der from Fréhel, La java from Mistinguett, Si vous étiez un coquin from Arletty as well as two new songs specifically written for this album Brexzut! and Chez Raymond which relates the lives of French expats in the UK.
